You will need:


scissors, glue, string and adult to help with the tricky bits.

4. If you like, make a small hole at the end of the tail, thread some string through and hang it up or scare a grown-up with it!

You will need:


scissors, crayons or paint, glue, string and adult to help with the tricky bits.
