

Make a coiled snake

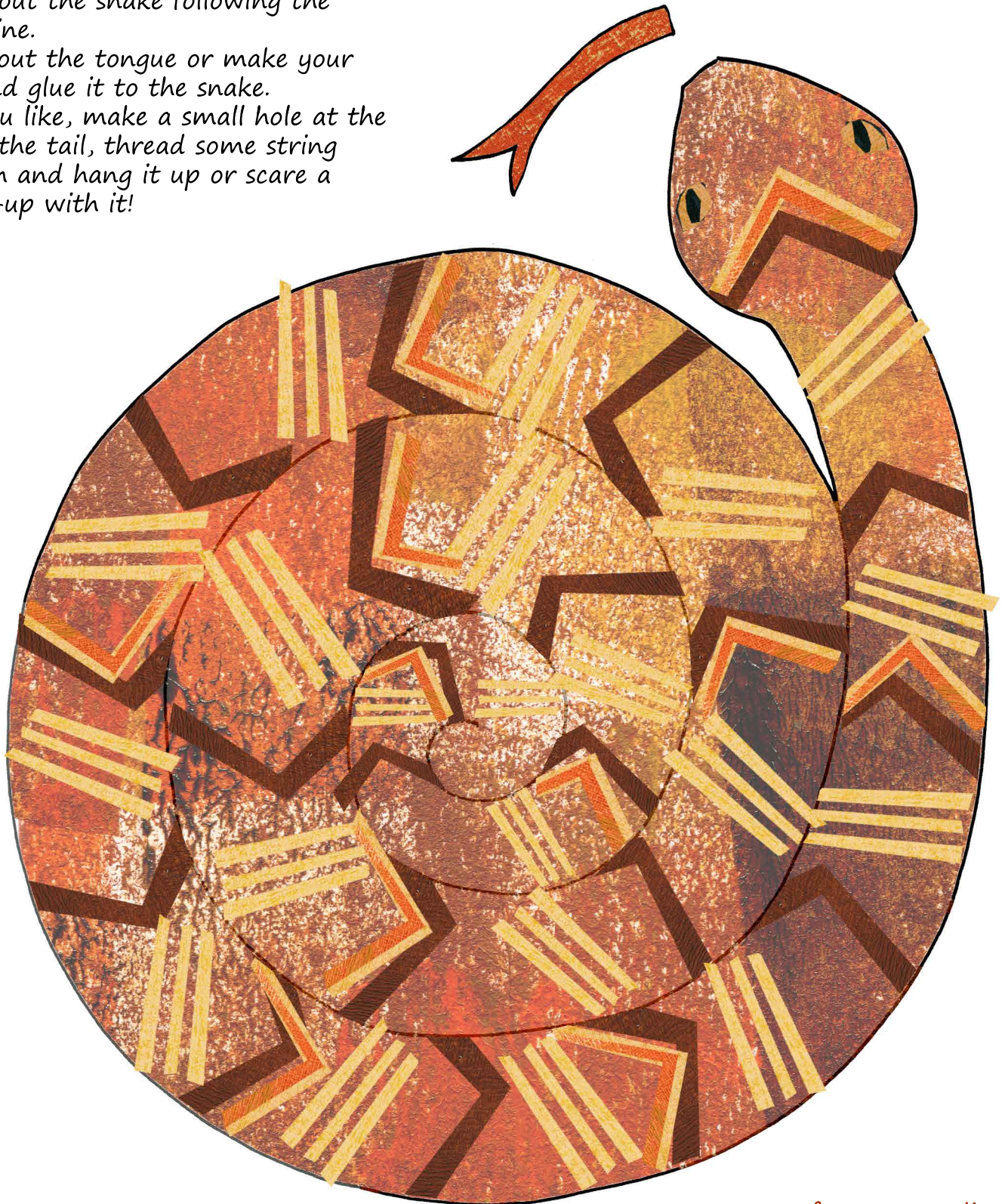
You will need:

scissors, glue, string and adult to help with the tricky bits.

Print out the template on page 2 to make a snake all of your own.

What to do:

- 1 Cut out the snake following the outer outline.
2. Cut out the snake following the spiral line.
3. Cut out the tongue or make your own and glue it to the snake.
4. If you like, make a small hole at the end of the tail, thread some string through and hang it up or scare a grown-up with it!



Make your own coiled snake - template

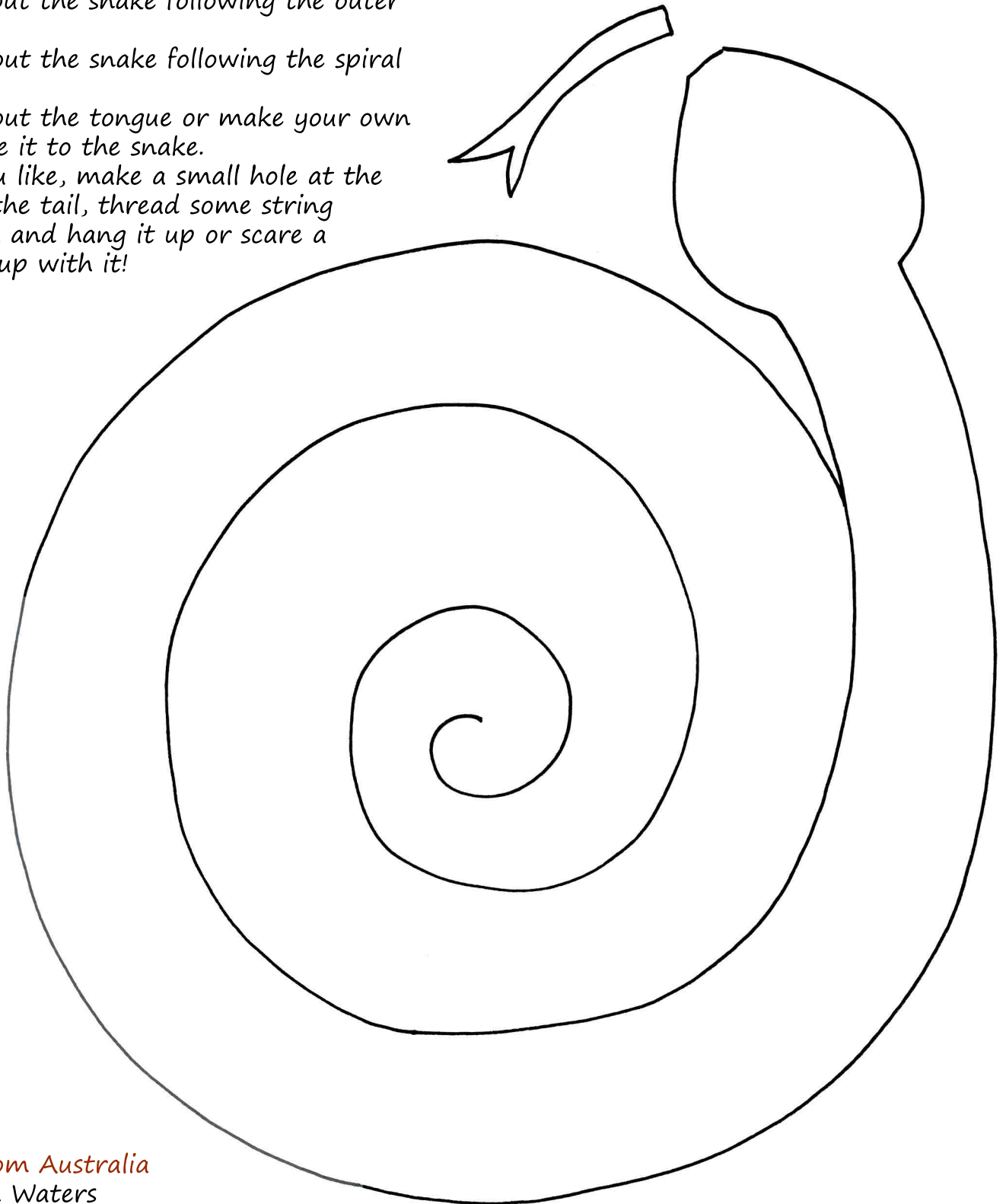
You will need:

scissors, crayons or paint, glue, string and adult to help with the tricky bits.

What to do:

1. Print out this sheet.
2. Draw patterns and colour the snake.
3. Cut out the snake following the outer outline.
4. Cut out the snake following the spiral line.
5. Cut out the tongue or make your own and glue it to the snake.
6. If you like, make a small hole at the end of the tail, thread some string through and hang it up or scare a grown-up with it!

Try using old paint brushes, toothbrushes and sponges to create different textures.
